

Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. **1. Introduction**

- 1.1. The Indian National Centre for Ocean Information Services (INCOIS), an autonomous organization under the Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES), Government of India, is a premier institution committed to providing ocean data, information, and advisory services on a 24x7 basis.
- 1.2. As part of its infrastructure maintenance and operational safety strategy, INCOIS has planned the Supply and installation of pigeon nets and spikes at the Main Building and ITCO Hostel Block in Hyderabad. These installations are intended to address the significant pigeon infestation, which is impacting cleanliness, posing hygiene risks, and causing long-term maintenance challenges.
- 1.3. Under this tender, INCOIS invites qualified agencies for carrying out the SITC of pigeon nets and spikes, which includes a standard warranty of three years post-installation, as specified in the tender document. The scope of work also includes all associated fixing and mounting systems required for effective bird proofing.
- 1.4. Given the criticality of INCOIS operations and the need for a clean and safe environment, the installation is to be carried out with utmost precision and adherence to safety and quality standards. Vendors are encouraged to inspect the installation site to acquaint themselves with the layout and logistical considerations before submitting their bids

**2. Scope of work:**

The scope of work involves the supply and installation of durable and effective pigeon nets at designated areas of the Main Building and ITCO Hostel block. The work shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

For any delay in the completion of the entire scope of work (supply and installation of nets and spikes at both Main Building and ITCO Hostel) beyond the stipulated completion date, as per the agreed-upon project schedule, Liquidated Damages (LD) shall be levied at 0.5% (zero point five percent) of the total contract value per week of delay or part thereof. The total Liquidated Damages for delay shall not exceed 10% (ten percent) of the total contract value.

**Provision:**

- Delay attributable to INCOIS (e.g., non-provision of site access, delay in approvals, force majeure events) shall be duly considered and an extension of time granted without levy of LD.
- The decision of INCOIS regarding the calculation and levy of LD shall be final and binding.
